- _____ _____ LFFE programs are supportive, inclusive and wholesome experiences. Students are expected to:
- o Support everyone in the group—students and leaders.
 - o Include everyone in all aspects of the group's time together.
 - o Make the group's experience a wholesome one through appropriate behavior and language.
 - o Recognize that group living requires cooperation, compromise and consideration for others.
- _____ _____ LFFE meals require compromise, flexibility and a positive attitude:
- o There are typically six "meals" a day: breakfast, snack, lunch, snack, dinner & dessert.
 - o All members of the group share all meals and snacks together.
 - o Leaders and students decide on meals and snacks for the group together.
 - o Everyone has to be flexible at meal and snack times to accommodate the group.
 - o If you are a vegetarian, please keep in mind that vegetarian meals are prepared by withholding the meat portion of whatever the group having (for example, spaghetti with a meatless sauce).
 - o LFFE cannot accommodate vegans, kosher diets, or students with severe food allergies.
- _____ _____ LFFE's safety and supervision policies include the following basics:
- o LFFE groups stick together except for the occasional opportunity for small amounts of free time. Students need to understand that free time during trips is structured to ensure student safety; in general: students are always paired up, there is a time limit (generally no more than 30 minutes), there is a set area in which to explore, LFFE leaders are always present and available during free time, and free time is not allowed after dark.
- _____ _____ LFFE prohibits the possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs.
- _____ _____ (Student Only) I will strive to be a positive, cooperative and enthusiastic member of my group, and I will find ways to make my group's experience a positive one for all involved.
